#### PROJECT ABSTRACT: WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS EQUIPMENT

The S&CCLSD is a Chautauqua County Government Enterprise Department whose service mission is to protect human health and the environment from pollution. The Sewer Districts were formed in 1969 to protect Chautauqua Lake and the associated watershed (Mississippi River/Gulf of Mexico). Existing Town and Village sewers constructed during the 1930s and 1940s were accepted by S&CCLSD. A \$50,000,000 sewer expansion and treatment works project occurred during the late 1970s and early 1980s.

THE PROJECT IS TO REPLACE A PORTION OF THE HEAVY DUTY HIGH PRECISION ROTATING EQUIPMENT AT THE TREATMENT WORKS THAT HAVE BEEN IN CONTINUOUS SERVICE SINCE 1980. THESE PRODUCTS HAVE A DESIGN USEFUL LIFE OF 20-25 YEARS (EXCEEDED AT S&CCLSD BY DILIGENT MAINTENANCE AND EMERGENCY REPAIRS). THE PROJECT IS VERY LABOR INTENSIVE WITH ESTIMATED PAYROLL COSTS AS FOLLOWS:

THE SEWER DISTRICTS HAVE INCURRED COSTS TO DATE OF \$602,841 SINCE 2003. THIS WAS FOR NEW REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT, REPAIR PARTS AND SERVICES AND, MAINTENANCE OF ALL TREATMENT WORKS EQUIPMENT. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE INTERNAL LABOR COSTS.

THE CONSTRUCTION AND LABOR COSTS TABULATED ABOVE INCLUDE PRECISION HEAVY MANUFACTURE OF EQUIPMENT. SUCH PRODUCT COSTS ARE ESTIMATED TO BE \$1,200,000 OF WHICH \$720,000 (60%) ARE LABOR COSTS. MANY PRODUCTS WERE ORIGINALLY PRODUCED BY NY STATE FABRICATORS WHO ARE STILL IN BUSINESS AND THE EQUIPMENT SHALL BE REPLACED USING SIMILAR SPECIFICATIONS TO THOSE ORIGINALLY USED 30 YEARS AGO. THE NEW EQUIPMENT INCLUDES CLARIFIER DRIVE REDUCERS (7), AERATOR SURFACE TURBINES (6), ARCHIMEDES SCREW LIFTS (2), COMMINUTORS (2), AND CHLORINE MIXER (1).

THIS PROJECT DOES NOT REQUIRE ANY NYSDEC PERMITS NOR SEQRA CLEARANCES AND, AS THUS, IS "READY TO GO".
